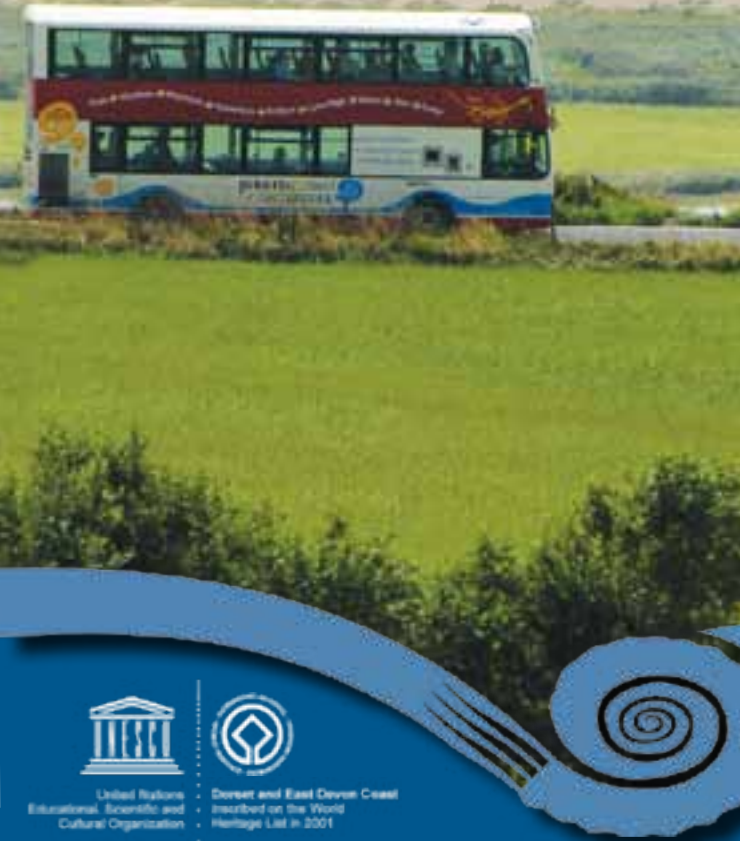


TRAVEL MAP

Welcome to the Dorset and East Devon Coast
England's only natural World Heritage Site.

More commonly known as the Jurassic Coast, this special place is a World Heritage Site because of its incredible geology which represents 185 million years of earth history in just 95 miles.

Take a 'walk through time' along the South West Coast Path from the older, Triassic red rocks in East Devon through the Jurassic rocks in Dorset, finishing at the younger Cretaceous chalk rocks at Old Harry near Swanage.

Take a 'bus-ride through time' on the CoastlinX53 which runs between Exeter in East Devon and Poole in Dorset, following the coastline with some fabulous sea views, stopping off at seaside towns along the way, and linking with other buses where the route deviates from the coast.

Which bus do I catch?

Find the place you wish to travel from and the destination you want to reach. If a route number is shown where the two points meet this is your direct bus service. For example if travelling from Lyme Regis to Weymouth read down from Lyme Regis and across from Weymouth. This shows X53 is your direct service. Where no number is shown a change of bus will be necessary.
